LEGISLATION


First Reading: Ordinance 08-2020, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE USE OF FACIAL MASKS IN PUBLIC TO MITIGATE THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


Discussion; Mr. O'Shea, City of Cincinnati previously passed legislation similar to Ord 8 prior to Hamilton County and The Governor mandate.. Mr. O'Shea is concerned to see some of the things in this particular ordinance considering the concerns Cincinnati has. They have recognized inconsistencies between their own legislation and the mandate from state and/or the county. One in particular in our legislation as well as Cincinnati's compared to the county is the age of the children and different discussions on how it would be enforced. The City of Cincinnati is still trying to finalize plans of enforcement. He is concerned to have it pushed to special meeting without going through committee review. Mr. Miller Novak is not sure it needs to be reviewed. When NCH discussed this the county didn't have any measure to compare it with. Moving it to a committee for review would take too much time. What's the point of doing something with an emergency clause if it takes 2-3 months to get it done? Mr. O'Shea mentions he still has a motion on the floor to move Ord 8 to Safety Committee. Ms. Bailey asked Ms. Underwood date of next Safety Committee meeting. She said the 4th Monday in July. Vote is taken. Motion fails 3-2.
